TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

Dissertation Research: "The Clash of Demography and Politico-Religiosity: Attitudes toward Homosexuality in Turkey"

I explore public attitudes toward homosexuality in Turkish society, using data from two waves (1990 and 2011) of the WVS. I ascertain the degree to which attitudes toward homosexuality are influenced by both demographic values and politico-religious values. I test two competing main hypotheses, supported by demographic transition theory and the mobilization of political Islam.



Research Article: “Patriarchal Attitudes in Turkey 1990-2011: The Influence of Religion and Political Conservatism”

Using the five waves of the WVS, in this article, I demonstrate the attitudinal change in economic, familial, political, and educational patriarchal attitudes in Turkey from 1990 to 2011, and I examine how these attitudes are influenced by religiosity and level of political conservatism. Our findings inform us that Turkey does not follow the pattern of Western societies regarding issues related to gender equality even though it has had a secular, democratically elected government for most of 20th Century. In fact, we find that patriarchal values are more prominent in 2011 than 1990.

Research Article: “Attachment to Society and Cognitive Deviance: The Case of Turkey.”

Utilizing the 2011 wave of the WVS, the findings show that that the level of attachment to society reduces cognitive deviance. Moreover, the effect is stronger towards more extreme cognitive deviance, such as tolerance towards homosexuality and people with AIDS than less extreme cognitive deviance, such as tolerance towards divorce and abortion

Research Article: “Natural Decrease in Semi-Peripheral Nations: County-Level Analyses of Mexico and Turkey”

My colleagues and I ascertain the extent to which natural decrease was occurring among the counties of Mexico and among the provinces of Turkey. In addition to dealing with the issue of natural decrease, we also inquired about the methodological issue of spatial autocorrelation.

Research Article: “Structural Changes in Marriage and Family in Turkey”

Analysing the data from both Turkish Statistical Institute and the World Values Survey, this paper traces the demographic changes in marriage and family in Turkey.

Research Article: “LGBT in Turkey: Policies and Experiences”

In this research paper, I examine the political attitudes toward LGBT individuals by analyzing disparate viewpoints of Turkish parliamentary members and explore the experiences of twenty-five transgender individuals that shed light on the difficulties of being a trans-individual in Turkey.

Research Article: “Sex Work in Turkey: Experiences of Transwomen”

This piece is intended for both academic and non-academic audiences. I focus on the current sex work policy in Turkey, a predominantly Muslim society where prostitution is legal in the form of state run brothels, or *genelev*. I specifically analyze the status of fifty-three transgender sex workers and how they are influenced by the current *genelev* system.
