



Eligibility of organisations from non-EU countries

Article 8 of the Regulation No 1295/2013 establishing **the Creative Europe Programme** stipulates that other countries than EU Member States may participate in the Programme. This participation is subject to the conditions referred to in the same article.

The table below gives an indication of non-EU countries that are likely to fulfil these conditions in time to be eligible for the current calls for proposals. Cultural and creative organisations from these countries can therefore apply with reasonable assurance to the different calls. However, the final selection of projects from these countries is dependent on the conclusion of an Agreement with the European Commission before the award decisions for the projects. Please refer to the guidelines for the different calls for further details and timetables.

Please also be aware that deadlines for applications under the 2014 calls are from March onwards (see: http://ec.europa.eu/culture/calls/index_en.htm).

Countries not mentioned in the above list either did not officially express their interest in participating in Creative Europe or will most possibly not be able to conclude an Agreement with the European Commission in time for the 2014 grant award decisions. The European Commission will update this information at the moment when one of those countries becomes eligible.

¹ For Georgian organisations, partial participation in the MEDIA Sub-programme will be possible, i.e. participation in training, festivals, audience development and market access activities.
