

Master programme in “Law and Policies of European Integration” (DIE)

ADMISSION

The Master DIE program is intended for:

- Graduate students (with bachelor’s degree or equivalent title)
- Postgraduate students
- Research students

The maximum number of students enrolled for each year is about 40.

Applicants can submit their applications starting from the 15th of March of each year.

Applicants must finalize the online pre-registration process on the Master DIE website (www.mastereu.com).

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. a bachelor’s degree or equivalent title preferably in political science, law or related subjects.
Applicants should have earned at least 36 ECTS credits or equivalent in the following fields: Contemporary History, Law, Economics, Sociology, Politics.
2. Applicants should have good knowledge of English and French, both written and spoken. The knowledge of the two languages will be tested by means of an interview or, by possessing one valid language certificate which is recognised as proof of language abilities internationally.
3. The admission to the course is subjected to the preventive selection procedure which is based on the production of the following documents:
 - CV
 - A copy of the Diploma enabling access to the course
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - Report
 - Cover letter
 - (not compulsory) language certificates
