I am Project Leader in Onco-Immunology in the Department of Biotechnologies and Translational Medicine at Humanitas Clinical and Research Center, in Rozzano (Milan). I received my PhD in Immunology at Mario Negri Institute of Pharmacological Research and further trained as a post-doctoral fellow at Mount Sinai Immunobiology Institute, in New York. In 2013 I got the position as Assistant Professor in Pathology at the University of Milan. Within the field of onco-immunology, my area of expertise is the clinical relevance of immune infiltrating cells in solid tumors, highly focused on colo-rectal, lung and pancreatic cancer. Primary aims are the identification of novel biomarkers of clinical outcome in cancer patients and the evaluation of immune-therapeutic targets in preclinical models.
