Call for Applications for the awarding of a Special Grant for the 2020/21 Academic Year

Promulgated with Rector's decree no. 2731/2020 of 14 July 2020

Special Grants are awarded until the allocated funds are exhausted.

Special Grants are available to those receiving other types of grants and financial aid. Grants may only be awarded once over the course of each academic year and, with respect to any given request type, once during the student's academic career.

The total grant award cannot exceed € 1,500.00.

Grants may be awarded in the following cases:

- a) students facing severe economic distress within their family, where the household has lost its main source of income;
- b) illness, injuries, surgeries, or expensive medical treatment having a serious impact on the student or the student's family members, jeopardising their academic career;
- c) the passing of a member of the student's nuclear family.

The incident or circumstances must occur between **1 October 2019 and 30 September 2020**. Enrolled students meeting the income and academic-enrolment requirements contemplated for DSU Scholarships under the education incentive programme for the 2020/21 academic year may submit an application:

- through the first "off-track" year for those enrolled in a Bachelor's degree, single-cycle Master's degree, Master's degree programme, through the second "off-track" year for students with a disability assessed at or above 66%;
- solely during "on-track" enrolment years for students enrolled in a doctoral or post-graduate programme.

Applications must be submitted online no later than 15 December 2020 using the following link:

For applications submitted for the reasons listed in (a)-(c) above, specific supporting documents proving the events for which the grant is requested must be provided. Applications submitted without such documentation will be automatically rejected.
