For summer 2021, the SLAM - University of Milan Language Centre organises International Courses of Italian Language and Culture in Gargnano on Lake Garda. The courses are open to international users of the University and foreign citizens who have a level of Italian language proficiency equal to B1 at the least in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

The University of Milan international users can apply for a scholarship, whereas foreign citizens can submit a self-funded application whose participation fee is equal to €500,00.

Each course round lasts three weeks and consists of 84-hour teaching of Italian language and culture:

- * 1st round from 28 June to 17 July 2021
- * 2nd round from 19 July to 7 August 2021



Daily activities (from Monday to Friday):

- * 9.00 a.m. 1.00 p.m. Italian language classes held by experienced and highly qualified teachers. Small groups divided according to the different proficiency levels.
- * 1.00 p.m. 5.30 p.m. Lunch and free time
- * 5.30 p.m. 7.15 p.m. Conferences on literature, art, theatre, cinema, music and history, related to Italian culture and society, held by lecturers.

The programme also includes cultural activities, among which a visit to the Verona Arena to attend an opera performance, a visit to the Vittoriale degli Italiani, home to poet Gabriele D'Annunzio, a visit to the 16th century "La Malora" lemon house and a boat trip on the shores of the Lake of Garda.
