Main activities and responsibilities

In the capacity of Director of Ctu she coordinated about thirty units of personnel, between full time employees and external consultants and carried out e-learning and multimedia design, development and implementation activities addressing 2.500 faculty. Among the main projects undertaken:

- In 2002 she co-designed and supervised the development of 'Ariel', an in-house VLE devoted to support ICT- enhanced teaching. In the same year she organized the international e-learning conference "E-learning: challenges, methods, perspectives". - In 2003 she contributed to the delivery phase of a national e-learning survey organized by the ANEE Observatory and participated in the final presentation of findings.
- In 2004 she coordinated, together with prof. Lorenzo Cantoni (University of Lugano – Switzerland), an e-learning survey about "Quality in the management of e-learning projects", across all the Italian universities.
- Between 2004 and 2006 she co-authored (with L. Cantoni) one cycle of e-learning seminars lectured by international experts and addressed to professionals and PHD students.
- Between 2003 and 2006 she taught as a temporary lecturer in some master programs by the University of Milan.
- In 2004 she carried out a feasibility study and then designed and coordinated the very first online degree program (in "ICT Security", undergraduate level) at the University of Milan and one of the first ones in Italy. The project was successfully implemented and is currently offered, enrolling an average of a hundred of freshmen per year.
- In 2005 redesign the multimedia production sector for the new location of the CTU: now the center is fully equipped for radio and tv online broadcasting, which is one of the core activity of the local Master in Journalism.
- Between 2005 and 2006 she contributed to two EU funded projects: EUREA and eLERU, in a partnership lead by the LERU (League of the European Research Universities).
- Between 2005 and 2006 she re-organized the local university library, which became a reference resource on e-learning and media production topics, among the Italian university libraries.
- In 2007 she co-designed (with the Ctu Scientific Committee) and carried out a survey (comprised of an online questionnaires and a series of focus groups), among teaching staff of the University of Milan, in order to collect data and opinions to provide the University Board informed suggestions for an e-learning strategic planning.
- In 2007 she coordinated an experimental lab aiming to elaborate a feasibility study for the creation of a university web radio, which can be both a communication tool and a teaching/ learning instrument.

- From 2003 to 2007 she has taken part in the E-learning Observatory led by the CRUI (Conference of the Rectors of the Italian Universities).
