PROJECT ACTIVITY

Year	Project
2018 - 2019	I performed feature engineering using SPSS and Excel on a project investigating algorithm bias in criminal trials. The work I conducted contributed to establish a proof of concept that went into four funding bits.
2018 - 2019	I undertook a research project for the Doctoral College at the University of Surrey to investigate what are the attributes of outstanding postgraduate research students and how these attributes can be measured, if at all.
	The project involved an integrative literature review and a report presenting the findings. The research output was used to inform the upper management involved in an ongoing strategy to upscale the University research goals.
2011	As a research intern at the University of East London I conducted a mixed methods investigation exploring if there was a market opportunity for cargo bikes in Hackney (London) for a local CargoBike start-up business.
	This project involved a systematic literature review and in-depth interviews, observations and a survey as data collection methods. Collected data was analysed using specific software such as NVivo and SPSS. Conversational analysis and participant observation were used as the
