Francesco Molteni is an Assistant Professor (rtd-A) in the Department of Social and Political Sciences at the University of Milano. He holds a PhD in Sociology and Methodology of Social Research. His main research interests include religion and religious change, values and attitudes' transmission and socialization, migration, and acculturation processes. He mainly works with large-scale comparative and national surveys and has also worked on three original datasets: CARPE, ResPOnSE COVID-19 and COValues. His work has been published in international peer-reviewed journals such as *Social Forces*, *Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*, *Sociology of Religion*, *European Societies*, and the *British Journal of Sociology*. He has also published with Brill the book "A Need for Religion: Insecurity and Religiosity in the Contemporary World." He is the P.I. of the project "Between Origin and Destination (BOnD)", funded by the CARIPLO foundation.
