TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

Lab Experiment: “Does sabotage reduce subsequent cooperation?” This project uses laboratory experiments to investigate whether sabotage in competitive settings influences individuals' cooperation decisions. Skills acquired: Designing and conducting laboratory experiments.
Online Experiment: “Restoring a Cooperative Mindset in Competitive Environments: the Role of Donation” This project employs online experimental methods to examine how donation programs affect subsequent cooperation. It further embeds a replication exercise on the existence of spillover effects of tournament incentives on cooperation decisions. Skills acquired: Designing and conducting online experiments and replication.
Empirical Study (<i>in progress</i>): “Information Diffusion, Networks and Polarization” (with Alessandro Bucciol, Federico Innocenti e Simone Quercia). This study analyzes empirical and experimental data to explore the cognitive mechanisms behind the spread of information. Skills acquired: Text classification, OpenAI API utilization, empirical data analysis.
Empirical Study (<i>in progress</i>): “Priming in Economics: a Meta-Analysis” (with Anna Dreber, Simone Quercia and Eric Luis Uhlmann). This project evaluates the effectiveness of priming techniques in influencing behavior using meta-analytical methods. Skills to be acquired: Meta-analysis techniques.
Field Experiment (<i>in progress</i>): “New Accountability Relationship in the Public Healthcare System: The Effect of Information Release in South Africa” (with Earle J. du Plooy and Giovanni Righetti). We test the impact of an information provision intervention on healthcare providers' and users' perceived accountability.
