



SELECTION CALL FOR STUDENT EXCHANGES

IN JAPAN

(FALL 2026)

The University of Milan – UNIMI invites applications for academic study periods at Doshisha University – Graduate School of Law (Kyoto), in the frame of a bilateral Student Exchange Agreement.

Up to **2** students will be selected to spend a semester at Doshisha University*, approximately 5 months, from September, 2026.

*the agreement with this Partner is under renewal. Mobility will only be possible if the agreement has been renewed.

Study abroad provisions

The study period abroad will be recognized as part of the academic program.

The study plan to be carried out abroad will be agreed and formalized through a Learning Agreement signed between the academic coordinators of both Universities (Home and Host Institution) and the student, prior to departure. A draft of Learning Agreement will be provided.

Admission requirements

Applicants must be regular students of the Master Degree Program in “Public and Corporate Communication – COM” during the current academic year.

The following eligibility requirements must be satisfied when applying as well:

- applicants’ CFU credits must be no less than 9;
- applicants’ weighted cumulative grade point average must be no less than 25/30;
- applicants must prove their English proficiency (level B2 or higher). As per Partner request, applicants must have passed the following English language proficiency tests: either IELTS (at least 6.0) or TOEFL (iBT 79 or higher, PBT 550 or higher). Only for UNIMI selection, applicants can just submit any B2 level certificate. In this last case, selected candidates are



encouraged to obtain the abovementioned certifications before the start of the mobility at Doshisha University.

Mobility requirements

Selected students must be regular enrolled in the above-mentioned study programs for the a.y. 2026-2027.

The status of student, guaranteed by the regular payment of UNIMI fees, must be maintained for the entire duration of the study period abroad.

Application procedure

Applicants must submit their application along with all the relevant documents through the online platform [elixForms](#).

Documents required are the following:

1. copy of a valid identity document, possibly a passport if already in the possession of the candidate (pdf);
2. curriculum vitae (pdf);
3. screenshot of the UNIMIA page showing matricola number, list of exams taken and average marks, along with the screenshot of the UNIMIA page showing their previous career and graduation grade; students that have graduated in a different University than UNIMI must also fill up the form [Dichiarazione sostitutiva di iscrizione, conseguimento titolo, esami \(box 2\)](#) or, if available, submit the certification issued by the University where they graduated, with the information related to their undergraduate degree and career records (pdf);
4. draft of the study plan to be carried out abroad (pdf);
5. statement of purpose in English (a letter explaining the scope of the mobility- pdf);
6. English proficiency certificate (pdf).



Application deadline

All the documents required must be sent by **January, 30, 2026** at **12 pm** (Italian local time), under penalty of exclusion from the selection.

Selection procedure

The applications will be assessed by a selection committee.

On the basis of the applicants' dossiers, the committee will assign up to 60 points to each applicant, as follows:

- 10 points: *curriculum vitae*
- 30 points: academic career and grades
- 10 points: statement of purpose
- 10 points: proficiency in English

Only applicants achieving an overall score of at least 40/60 will qualify for the selection.

Selection results

The final ranking will be published online on the UNIMI website [here](#), by **February 6, 2026**.

No personal communication will be sent to the applicants.

The first two positions of the ranking will be automatically confirmed as selected candidates. Any withdrawal must be sent within 3 days from the online publication of the ranking, through this [link](#).

Ufficio Mobilità internazionale e per la Promozione internazionale (Office) will contact any eligible student who will replace the renouncer in the ranking and will send the data of the selected candidates to the Host Universities for final approval.

All the information necessary for this purpose will be communicated by e-mail. It will be the responsibility of the selected student to carefully check the e-mail address communicated at the time of application: it is recommended to use an address clearly showing name and surname.



Insurance coverage

Exchange students will be covered with University of Milan civil liability insurance and accident insurance exclusively during the performance of their study activities at the Host University.

Accordingly, they will personally provide for a general civil liability and accident insurance as well as medical insurance coverage during their stay abroad.

Mobility costs

Exchange students will pay tuition and fees to the Home University. The Host University will waive tuition and fees. Travel and living costs (room and board, local transport, etc.), for the visa and health insurance will be borne by the student, except as indicated below.

Financial aspects

The University of Milan will award a grant according to the student's income, based on ISEE statement as already submitted to Divisione Segreteria Studenti.

Here below are specified the awarding criteria:

| ISEE (€) | MONTHLY ALLOWANCE (€) | TRAVEL GRANT (€) |

| from 13.000 to 21.000 | 650 | |

The amount of the grant corresponds to the actual period of mobility spent abroad. Should it last shorter than that established by the call, it will result in a partial refund of the contribution itself.

Important Notice for International Students

Please note that International students whose household resides and has their income abroad, are not required to submit their ISEE. Therefore, such students' ISEE value will correspond to the equivalent ISEE ("ISEE parificato") issued by the CAF - Tax Assistance Center. Once selected, students will be required to submit the "ISEE parificato".
