My subjects of expertise are logic (mathematical, computational, and philosophical), computer mathematics, cognitive science, and philosophy of mind.
I focus on pure and applied logic. I am particularly interested in the mathematical/philosophical notion of logical consequence and its applications in (non-)classical computation.
More generally, I research into formal languages (especially logical languages) and their applications in human and artificial cognition.
I am also interested in knowledge representation and cognitive modeling, conceived both narrowly (symbolic & connectionist models) and broadly (e.g., mental representation [in, say, Aristotle]), and in unconscious cognition.
