TRAINING OR RESEARCH ACTIVITY

I studied International Relations as bachelor in one of the leading universities in Turkey, Middle East Technical University (METU), graduated with a high-honor degree and with a minor in Political Science. Then, I was awarded an MBA degree by the same institution. For my master's thesis, I explored the glass cliff phenomenon for the first time in Turkey by examining differences in perceived suitability and leadership ability of men and women for leadership positions in high and poor performing companies. For my research, I gathered data through questionnaires and analyzed it with SPSS. After achieving MBA degree, I had a chance to to gain work experience in a private bank in Turkey, thus to be able to apply theoretical knowledge provided by my master's program on real business projects. I also worked as a Research Assistant in International Relations Department of Izmir University, Turkey, for more than two years.

Currently, I am about to complete my PhD degree in European Studies, which is an inter-disciplinary program in Graduate School of Social Sciences in Dokuz Eylul University, Izmir, Turkey. During my PhD programme, I gained comprehensive knowledge of EU's institutions and policies. My research interests include but not limited to EU governance, trade and development policy, business and industry.

For my dissertation, I examined the role of EU institutions on common commercial policy by specifically focusing on how the distribution of competences and conflictual interactions among institutions



influences EU trade policy outcomes. To enrich my study with international experience, I visited the University of Milan/Network for the Advancement of Social and Political Studies (NASP) for ten months as a visiting researcher. My research was sponsored by European Commission Jean Monnet Scholarship Programme 2018-2019 and guided by Prof. Fabio Franchino. For my research, I qualitatively analyzed political-economic preferences of European Commission, European Parliament and the Council of the EU towards EU-Canada Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) and their impact on the final agreement. I conducted content analysis to relevant official documents of EU legislative institutions and to the main text of the trade agreement. The results of the research was published in an peer-reviewed international journal.

My academic work also include a book chapter on normative dimension of EU trade policy with respect to EU-Africa economic relations (published in Turkish) and an abstract in an international conference book which summarizes my research on European Commission's autonomy during CETA negotiations.

I have advanced level of English proficiency since the medium of instruction in Middle East Technical University is English. I learned German during preparatory year program on German language in my high school and improved it later by attending to an intensive course in Germany sponsored by DAAD scholarship. To learn Italian, I attended to Italian language courses in Italian Cultural Institute in Izmir, Turkey. During my recent research visit comprising two semestres, I also attended to Italian language courses B1/B2 in the University of Milan.
