ongoing	This thesis examines the behavior in national legislatures of the parties Podemos (Spain) and the Five Star Movement (Italy)- parties that exhibit populist ideological attributes and, at the same time, originated with a hybrid organizational structure (movement parties) It covers the period between their first access to parliament to their first governmental term (to date). The goal is to explore the populist understanding of the concept of representation, and the actual performance of representation of the parties and their parliamentarians, bringing together insights from representation theory (Hanna Pitkin and Michael Saward) and "role theory" in parliamentary sociology.
	I deploy a mixed-method research design in which I combine my own database containing all legislative initiatives sponsored by the two parties and party manifestos, coded according to the Comparative Agenda Project codebook, with semi-structured interviews I conducted with elected representatives (MPs), and survey data from the Candidate Selection Survey.
