



## SELECTION CALL FOR DOUBLE DEGREE PROGRAM IN FRANCE MOBILITY DURING THE ACADEMIC YEARS 2021-2022/2022-2023

The University of Milan- UNIMI has established an agreement with [Université Toulouse 1 Capitole-UT1, European School of Law Toulouse](#) for the activation of a Double Degree program, of “Laurea magistrale a ciclo unico in Giurisprudenza”, Italian, and “Master 2 de Droit”, French.

On the basis of the agreement, n° 5 places are available to study abroad at partner university.

### **Study program provisions**

The study abroad period will last two academic years and will take place during the entire fourth and fifth year of the above-mentioned study program.

The study period abroad will be recognized as part of the academic program.

During their stay at UT1 students will carry out the study program established by the Italian and French academic coordinators, indicated in the table at the bottom of the call (“Annexe I - Liste de cours”). The study abroad period will be agreed and formalized through a Learning Agreement signed between the academic coordinators of both Universities (Home and Host Institution) and the student, prior to departure. A draft of L.A. will be provided.

The participants will also write their Master’s dissertation under the co-direction of one supervisor of the UT1 and one of UNIMI; the thesis will be defended at UT1, with the possible participation of Professors from UNIMI.

### **Admission requirements**

Applicants must be regularly enrolled, in the current academic year, in the Single Cycle Degree in Law.

Applicants must prove French proficiency (level B2 or higher).

### **Mobility requirements**

Selected students must be regularly enrolled in their fourth year of the above-mentioned study program for the a.y. 2021-2022. Students more than one year behind their study program (fuori corso) cannot participate to the mobility.

The status of student, guaranteed by the regular payment of UNIMI fees, must be maintained for the entire duration of the study period abroad.

**Attention: should it not be allowed to reach the destination country, upon the consent of the Partner University, the exchange program will be held on a virtual basis.**



## Application procedure

Applicants must submit their application through the platform [elixForms](#).

Documents required are the following:

- copy of a valid identity document (pdf/jpeg);
- transcript of academic career, with the grades obtained in all the exams taken (screenshot of the relevant UNIMIA page- pdf/jpeg);
- Any certification attesting language skills in the French language. The certification must be included among those recognized by the University (in this regard, please refer to the following [link](#)). (pdf/jpeg).

If students do not have any valid language certification, they can prove their language skills by submitting, when already obtained, a certificate of level issued by [Servizio Linguistico dell'Ateneo di Milano - SLAM](#).: for the test click [here](#).

Proficiency statements made by a language teacher whatsoever will not qualify. Likewise, credits earned in “Accertamento delle conoscenze linguistiche” during the students’ academic studies will not qualify, unless they have been issued as a result of the students’ participation in a language course organized by SLAM, therefore accompanied by the certificate of level previously referred to.

## Application deadline

All the documents required must be sent by **March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021** at 12 pm (Italian local time), under penalty of exclusion from the selection.

## Selection procedures

The applications will be assessed by a selection committee, composed by: Dott.ssa Antonia Baraggia; Dott. Pasquale Pantalone; Dott.ssa Benedetta Cappiello; alternate member: Dott. Luigi Crema.

The Commission will select the candidates, evaluating the documentation presented on the basis of the following criteria:

- French language skills (up to 5 points)
- relevance and quality of previous academic career (up to 35 points)

Only candidates achieving an overall score of at least 25/40 will qualify for the interview, via videoconference on the platform Microsoft Teams. Students will be notified on the date of the interview.

The shortlisted applicants will receive an email informing them about their admission to the interview, and with the instructions to access it on Microsoft Teams.

Participation in the interview is mandatory, under penalty of exclusion from the selection procedure.



After completing the interviews, the committee will assign up to 10 points by evaluating the motivations expressed by the student regarding the double degree program (from 5 to 10 points).

## **Selection results**

The final ranking will be published online on the UNIMI website [here](#) by **April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021**. No personal communication will be sent to the candidates.

The positions of winners of the ranking will be automatically confirmed as selected candidates. Any withdrawal must be sent within 3 days from the online publication of the ranking, through this [link](#).

Ufficio Mobilità Internazionale e per la Promozione Internazionale (Office) will send the data of the selected candidates to the Host Universities for final approval.

All the information necessary for this purpose will be communicated by e-mail. It will be the responsibility of the selected student to carefully check the e-mail address communicated at the time of application: it is recommended to use an address clearly showing name and surname.

## **Insurance coverage**

During their stay abroad, the selected students will be covered by UNIMI insurance for third party liability and accidents, exclusively during the carrying out of institutional activities at the host university.

## **Mobility costs**

For the attendance of the courses, the host University will waive tuition and fees. Travel and accommodation expenses, including any supplementary insurance, are borne by the student, except as indicated below.

## **Financial aspects**

The University of Milan will award a grant according to the student's income, based on ISEE statement as already submitted to Divisione Segreteria Studenti.

For information purposes only, below are specified the awarding criteria. The Administrative Board will soon approve by decree the criteria and amounts updated to 2021/2022.

| <b>ISEE</b>                             | <b>Monthly allowance</b> |
|---|--------------------------|
| less or equal to 13.000 euros           | 500 euros                |
| from 13.000 to 21.000 euros             | 450 euros                |
| from 21.000 to 26.000 euros             | 400 euros                |
| from 26.000 to 30.000 euros and further | 350 euros                |

The amount of the grant corresponds to the actual period of mobility spent abroad. Should it last shorter than that established by the call will result in a partial refund of the grant itself.
