Specific Requirements

Who can apply:

- Students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme who earned at least 9 credits, which should be registered by the 2nd of March 2021
- Students enrolled in a Master's degree programme

Students enrolled in *Data Science and Economics* Master's degree programme must submit one application only. If the Area of Political, Economic and Social Sciences is chosen, only the destinations of this Area should be selected. Any other destination related to the Computer Science Area will not be taken into account by the Commission.

Language skills Assessment: language competences must be documented through an official certificate / SLAM certificate. Only certificates issued no longer than 3 years ago will be considered as valid. In case of tie, the official certificate / SLAM certificate attached to the application will be used as a selection criterion, as some Host Universities require a language level higher than A2 (please refer to the specific tables referred to the Host Universities). Only certificates issued no longer than 5 years ago will be considered as valid.
