- History (Bachelor's degree programme)
- Historical Studies (Master's degree programme)
- History, Culture and Theories of Society and Institutions (PhD)

Specific Requirements

Who can apply:

- Students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme who earned at least 12 credits, which should be registered by the 2nd of March 2021
- Students enrolled in a Master's degree programme
- Students enrolled in a Doctoral Programme

Selecting criteria:

the Erasmus Index score can award a maximum of 12 points (instead of 15) in this specific Area of Study.

The following additional points may be awarded by the Commission during the interview:

1) Evaluation of student's Learning Agreement proposal and motivations:

Minimum score 1	Maximum score 8

2) Evaluation of CV and previous academic career:

Minimum score 1	Maximum score 5

3) Evaluation of language skills:

Minimum score 1	Maximum score 5

Language skills Assessment: Language skills must be documented through an official certificate / SLAM certificate. Only certificates issued no longer than 3 years ago will be considered as valid.
