Specific Requirements

Who can apply:

- Students enrolled at least in their 3rd year of the single-cycle Master's degree programme in Medicine and Surgery, and in International Medical School

Please Note that some partner Universities require the submission of a clean bill of health and a copy of your Vaccination Certificate (at least rubella, tuberculosis and Hepatitis B).

Language skills Assessment: language skills must be documented through an official certificate / SLAM certificate. Only certificates issued no longer than 3 years ago will be considered as valid.

With regard to the English Language only: Students enrolled in IMS are considered proficient up to the entry level of the IMS course. These students are thus required to self-certify their English-language proficiency using Form 2. Students with a higher English level are required to show evidence as required in Annexe A.
