

# Humanities Area - Philosophy

## Courses:

- Philosophy (Bachelor's degree programme),
- Philosophical Sciences (Master's degree programme),

## Specific Requirements

### Who can apply:

- Students enrolled in a Bachelor's degree programme who earned at least 12 credits, which should be registered by the 2<sup>nd</sup> of March 2021
- Students enrolled in a Master's degree programme
- Students enrolled in a Doctoral Programme

### Selecting criteria:

the Erasmus Index score can award a maximum of 12 points (instead of 15) in this specific Area of Study.

The following additional points may be awarded by the Commission during the interview:
