In-person attendance

Supervision and specialist technical assistance in classrooms



Given the need to stream all classes, the University has implemented an in-person supervision and specialist technical assistance service to support instructors and other users of multimedia and traditional classroom systems.



MULTIMEDIA CLASSROOMS: characteristics of the supervision and assistance service



The service is provided by University employees and external resources identified through a public tender procedure. It includes the following activities:

- ✓ management of audio and video streaming systems in multimedia classrooms, to support instructors, where required, with recording and web-conference streaming;
- ✓ ensuring the proper operation of classroom systems and infrastructure, problem solving, including through remote support by the Contractor;
- ✓ regular reporting on multimedia classes, including any critical issues and/or malfunctioning.

All technicians will be available Monday through Friday from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm (with 1 hour break); one technician will be available on Saturdays from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm for the Via Conservatorio 7 campus.

In particular, technicians will be allocated as follows:

- 8 technicians in person on the campuses in the Milan Central Area, divided as follows:
 - → 4 technicians at Via Festa del Perdono, Via Santa Sofia and Piazza S. Alessandro;
 - → 2 technicians at Via Conservatorio (1 on Saturdays from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm);
 - → 1 technician at Via G. B. Grassi 74 (Sacco Hospital Teaching Centre);
 - → 1 technician at Via Noto 8 Milan or Piazza I. Montanelli 1 Sesto S. Giovanni (as needed).
- 7 technicians on the Città Studi campus, divided as follows:
 - → 1 technician in the Golgi Educational Sector, entrance from via Golgi 19;
 - → 2 technicians in the Celoria/Biology Educational Sectors;
 - → 2 technicians in the Colombo/Agriculture Educational Sector;
 - → 1 technician in the Mangiagalli/Saldini/Botticelli Educational Sectors;
 - → 1 technician in the Physics/Balzaretti/University Centre/Venezian Educational Sectors.

Depending on the needs that may arise during the course of the service, the University may change service hours and locations or staff allocation.

TRADITIONAL CLASSROOMS: Characteristics of the supervision and assistance service



The University has also implemented a supervision and specialist technical assistance service in person to support instructors and other users of **traditional classroom** equipment, with a focus on web-conference classes.

The service is provided by University employees and external resources identified through a public tender procedure. It includes the following activities:

- ✓ management of classroom equipment, to support instructors, where required, with webconference streaming;
- ✓ ensuring the proper operation of classroom systems and infrastructure, problem solving;
- ✓ regular reporting on the conditions of audio-video systems, including any critical issues and/or malfunctioning.





Technicians will be available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 pm; for the Via Conservatorio campus only, availability is extended to Saturdays from 9:00 am to 12:30 pm.

In particular, technicians will be allocated as follows:

- 3 technicians to the campuses in the Milan Central Area;
- 3 technicians to the Città Studi campus.

Depending on the needs that may arise during the course of the service, the University may change service hours and locations or staff allocation.

Computer equipment



During the months of August and September, new PCs with integrated webcams will be installed in 130 traditional classrooms as scheduled. Instructors can choose whether to use these PCs or their laptops.

Moreover, some laptops will be made available for use in case the classroom PC does not work and the instructor does not have a laptop. These PCs will be kept by support staff and must be returned at the end of the class, to make them available for subsequent classes.

Exams



Written and oral exams will take place in person, in compliance with safety and distancing rules. Exceptions to the in-person exam requirement will be granted only for the following reasons:

- a) Covid-19 positive or guarantined students
- b) Students with disabilities, as laid down by law
- c) Students residing in countries with health restrictions or cross-border travel restrictions.

The waiver request may be sent via email or the LezioniUnimi app.

The exam mode will be decided by the Academic Board and announced on the study programme website.

For the purposes of assessing disabilities, detailed information and guidelines will be provided by the Safety, Sustainability and Environment Division (Eng. Messina).

The self-certification form must be submitted to the course lead instructor and to the Head of the Study Programme, at least 4 days before the date of the exam.

LezioniUnimi App

For study programmes accepting waiver requests through the LezioniUnimi app, applications may be submitted up to 4 days before the date of the exam. The app will list the aforementioned reasons for applying for a waiver.

Moodle+SEB Exams



In-person exams on the Moodle+SEB platform may only be conducted in computer-equipped rooms as opposed to traditional classrooms, asking students to bring their own personal device.
