



**ENGLISH LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT COURSE WITH A VIEW TO SITTING THE CAMBRIDGE ASSESSMENT
ENGLISH INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE B2 FIRST (FCE)**

Description

SLAM - University of Milan Language Centre is organising English language development courses with a view to sitting the Cambridge B2 First (FCE) exam, for which the SLAM Centre is authorised exam centre pursuant to an agreement entered into by and between *Cambridge Assessment English* and the University of Milan.

Registration procedure and deadlines

Course registration is open to enrolled students at the University of Milan, including those whose graduation deadline is overdue, and to Unimi graduates for up to 12 months.

The registration fee is equal to **Euro 268,40** (Euro 220 + VAT), administrative fees and course materials included.

All prospective participants must submit their application by filling in the relevant online form:

<http://studente.unimi.it/ammissioni/a/certlin/checkLogin.asp>. During the procedure, you will have to pay the registration fee through one of the modalities provided by the PagoPA system.

Applications must be submitted **by and no later than 14th July 2022 at 11:59 p.m.**

There are 8 seats available. Please be informed that 5 participation requests at the least are needed for the course to be activated.

Registration is deemed as confirmed once you will have downloaded the registration receipt from the platform and received the payment confirmation email by the PagoPA system to your email address. Should your payment fail, your registration will not be deemed as confirmed.

After the date of expiry of the present notice, participants who managed to register successfully will be sent an email with further information and useful guidelines to attend the course.

Should the course fail to be activated due to a lack of attendees, registered participants will be given the opportunity whether to be refunded or ask for their registration to be validated for the following course edition.

Under the provisions laid down in Legislative Decree No. 196/2003, the University commits to respecting the confidentiality of all information provided by participants. All the data provided are processed for the



relevant purposes connected to the call exclusively and for entering into and managing a potential cooperation with the University, according to the legislation in force.

Refund

Should you find out that you will not be able to attend the course after having registered, you may request a refund of the sum paid by the application deadline of the present notice exclusively. For the refund to be issued, the applicant must be the holder or co-holder of the current account. Should this not be the case, the refund is not guaranteed.

Should the course fail to be activated due to a lack of attendees, registered participants will be contacted by the SLAM Centre to ask for their confirmation on whether they wish to be refunded or ask for their registration to be validated for the following course edition.

Course details

This course is aimed at developing English language skills with a view to sitting the Cambridge B2 First (FCE) exam. Therefore, please note that this course is addressed to those who already hold the aforementioned CEFR level and wish to learn tools and strategies useful for taking this exam effectively.

The course, of the overall duration of 20 hours, is made up of 10 lessons to be held in person at the SLAM Centre in 11, Santa Sofia street (20122, Milan) according to the timetable below:

Green Pass requirement
