- Presentation and discussion of the project proposals by the applicants
- Shortlisting and assessment of submitted proposals by an ad-hoc committee

### Shortlisting will be carried out according to the following assessment criteria:

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA	SCORE	
Project quality in terms of a)consistency and relevance of topics b)skills involved	max. 40 points	
2) Project originality and innovation	max. 15 points	
3) Impact and potential of expected outcomes and follow-up possibilities	max. 15 points	
4) Feasibility*, including cost adequacy and relevance	up to 30 points	

<sup>\*</sup> Projects have to be given prior authorization by the relevant correctional facility, in compliance with the limited access regulations that these facilities impose.

### 3<sup>rd</sup> STAGE

Submission of the shortlisted project proposals to the academic bodies.

### 4<sup>th</sup> STAGE

Notification of the shortlisting outcomes and presentation of project abstracts to the Correctional Facilities for the feasibility study and subsequent launch of the projects.
