



CELI ITALIAN LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE

Description

Pursuant to an agreement entered into by and between the University for Foreigners Perugia and the University of Milan, the University of Milan is a *CELI* exam centre for Italian language certificates.

On 11th and 12th March 2026 the following exams are taking place: *CELI 1 - A2*, *CELI 2 - B1*, *CELI 3 - B2*.

Registration procedure and deadlines

Both internal and external users to the University, of age exclusively, are entitled to register for the exam aimed at getting the aforementioned certificate.

Costs

Each exam costs 130 euros, broken down as follows:

- 100 euros: fixed amount laid down by the exam provider;
- 30 euros: administrative fees.

All candidates must submit their application and pay the registration fee by following the online procedure at this link:

Applications must be submitted by 12th February 2026 at 12 noon. Registration will be closed once the maximum number of available places has been reached.

- *CELI 1 A2*: 9 seats
- *CELI 2 B1*: 12 seats
- *CELI 3 B2*: 12 seats

Registration is deemed as confirmed once you will have downloaded the registration receipt from the platform and received the payment confirmation email by the PagoPA system to your email address. Should your payment fail, your registration will not be deemed as confirmed.

After the date of expiry of the present notice, candidates who managed to register successfully will be sent an email with further information and useful instructions to sit the exam.

Candidates who did not pass the written part (consisting of the following sections: Reading Comprehension, Written Production/Interaction, Linguistic Competence and Listening Comprehension), but passed the oral part, or vice versa, can capitalize on their partial result and resit the failed exam part within a year, paying 70% of the fee, by selecting the relevant option (“Partial amount”: 91 euros).

If candidates are absent because of serious reasons, the payment issued may be kept valid for the next exam session, provided that the candidate submits a medical certificate as a justification.

Should that be the case, the candidate will be compelled to sit the exam at the next available session exclusively; they will not have to pay the registration fee again, but still they will have to submit their application within the deadline.

It is only possible to cancel the registration to *CELI* exams by the application deadline (12th February 2026 at 12 noon). After that deadline, the registration fee will not be refunded. For the refund to be issued, the candidate must be the holder or co-holder of the current account. Should this not be the case, the refund is not guaranteed.

Please note that the registration fee paid by external users of the University of Milan does not include the insurance premium share related to the accident insurance policy. Candidates who wish to activate this policy must do so independently.

Under the provisions laid down in Legislative Decree No. 196/2003, the University commits to respecting the confidentiality of all information provided by the candidate. All the data provided are processed for the relevant purposes connected to the call exclusively and for entering into and managing a potential cooperation with the University, according to the legislation in force.

Characteristics of the exam

The paper-based *CELI* - Italian language certificate - exams organized by SLAM - University of Milan Language Centre are taking place at SLAM laboratories at 11, Santa Sofia street (20122 Milan) on **Wednesday, 11th March 2026 at 9.00 a.m. as regards CELI 2 - B1 and CELI 3 - B2 exams and at 2.00 p.m. as regards CELI 1 - A2 exam. Oral exams of all levels are taking place on Thursday, 12th March 2026 at the same venue.**



The exams consist of the following sections:

CELI 1 - A2

Part A (reading component) + part B (writing component): 2 hours

Part C (listening component): 20 minutes

Speaking part: 10 minutes per candidate

CELI 2 - B1

Part A (reading component) + part B (writing component): 2 hours

Part C (listening component): 20 minutes

Speaking part: 15 minutes per candidate

CELI 3 - B2

Part A (reading component) + part B (writing component): 2 hours and 15 minutes

BREAK

Parte C (language proficiency): 45 minutes

Parte D (listening component): 25 minutes

Speaking part: 15 minutes per candidate

Results

The exam results, assessed by the University for Foreigners Perugia, are published on the webpage <https://cvcl.unistrapg.it/accesso-candidati-celi> about 3 months after sitting the exam and are visible by entering the personal area online using the credentials you will be given on the exam day.

The original certificate is available in digital format about 5 months after sitting the exam.
