



REGULATIONS ON TUITION AND FEES, WAIVERS AND SCHOLARSHIPS ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027

Art. 1 – Scope

These regulations govern student tuition and fees, the criteria for total and partial waivers from tuition and fees, and the criteria for awarding scholarships for the academic year 2026/2027.

Art. 2 – Student tuition and fees

Student tuition consists of the single, all-inclusive annual fee set by the University, plus the regional tax for the right to higher education and the stamp duty.

Additionally, the University requires payment of specific fees for student services provided upon request.

Art. 3 – Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree programmes

Students enrolling in Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree programmes must pay the whole tuition due (i.e. all-inclusive annual fee + regional tax + stamp duty) in two instalments, in accordance with the terms and deadlines set forth in these regulations. As this is a single obligation, the payment of the first instalment gives rise to the obligation to pay the second instalment too.

Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree programmes are divided into two tuition areas as set out in Annex 1, which is an integral part of these regulations.

3.1 FIRST INSTALMENT

The first instalment consists of the minimum amount due for the regional tax, as established by Law no. 13 of the Lombardy Region dated 7 August 2025, plus the stamp duty.

Pursuant to article 6 of said regional law, the **amount due for the regional tax** varies according to the ISEE income brackets established by the Lombardy Region for the academic year 2025/2026, without prejudice to the revision of these thresholds adopted by the Lombardy Region for the academic year 2026/2027:

- First bracket: €130.00 for students with an ISEE up to €26,887.93
- Second bracket: €160.00 for students with an ISEE ranging between €26,887.94 and €53,755.88
- Third bracket: €190.00 for students with an ISEE above €53,755.88 or no submitted ISEE

Therefore, the **first instalment** amounts to **€146.00** (€130.00 for the regional tax + €16.00 for the stamp duty) and the following payment terms apply:

- ✓ For Bachelor's and Master's students who first matriculate in a degree programme: the first instalment is due upon enrolment and must be paid by the deadline specified in the relevant call for applications
- ✓ For Bachelor's and Master's students who have to renew enrolment: the first instalment must be paid between 15 July and 30 September 2026 by logging into the UNIMIA account (payments section).



The amount of the regional tax due by each student is based on the student's ISEE 2026. If the regional tax due exceeds €130.00, the outstanding balance will be collected together with the second instalment.

Those who intend to transfer to another degree programme of the University have to renew enrolment in the previous programme for the academic year 2026/2027, before applying for internal transfer.

Students who graduate within the third session of the academic year 2025/2026 and students who transfer to another university by the applicable deadlines, as set by resolution of the Academic Senate, are not required to renew enrolment.

Students renewing enrolment after the deadline will be charged a late enrolment fee, as set out in the following articles.

The late enrolment fee is also charged to those who apply to sit the final exam within the third graduation session of the academic year 2025/2026, but fail to graduate and consequently enrol in the academic year 2026/2027 after the deadline.

3.2 SECOND INSTALMENT

The second instalment consists of the all-inclusive fee and varies according to the economic situation of the student's household (as certified by their ISEE), the type of enrolment and the tuition area. The parameters for calculating the second instalment are the following:

1. On-track students and students who have been off-track for one year do not have to pay the second instalment if their ISEE is up to €30,000.00 (so-called no-tax area);
2. For students with an ISEE above €30,000.00 and up to €38,000.00: a 3% rate is applied to the difference between the student's ISEE and €25,000.00 (formula in table 2 for area A);
3. For students with an ISEE above €38,000.00 and up to €80,000.00: a 3% rate is applied to the difference between €38,000.00 and €25,000.00 plus a 6.7% rate is applied to the difference between the student's ISEE and €38,000.00 (formula in table 3 for area A);
4. For programmes in area B, a multiplication coefficient of 1.28 is applied (formula in table 2 for area B);
5. For students who have been off-track for two or more years, a multiplication coefficient of 1.50 is applied (formula in tables 2 and 3). The minimum second instalment, due by students with an ISEE up to €30,000.00, is in any case €200.00.
6. Students with an ISEE above €80,000.00 are charged the maximum second instalment, as specified below:

3.3 SECOND INSTALMENT PAYMENT DEADLINE AND PROCEDURES

Without prejudice to the provisions of article 3.5 regarding online degree programmes, all students who enrol by 30 November 2026 must pay the second instalment by 2 February 2027.

The payment link will be available in the student's UNIMIA account, as of 15 December 2026.

Students who enrol after 30 November 2026 and by 28 February 2027 must pay the second instalment by 30 April 2027. The payment link will be available in the student's UNIMIA account as of 31 March 2027.

By default, all students who enrol in the academic year 2026/2027 are charged the maximum second instalment, as shown in table 1 above.

To obtain a reduction on the second instalment, students must obtain the ISEE University certificate by 10 October 2026.

3.4 RESCHEDULING THE SECOND INSTALMENT

If the second instalment is equal to or higher than €700.00, students may request that this amount be staggered in four monthly instalments, without interest. This applies only to Bachelor's, Master's or single-cycle Master's degree students who enrol in the academic year 2026/2027 by 30 November 2026 (without prejudice to the provisions of article 3.5). The four instalments must be paid by the following deadlines:



1. 2 February 2027
2. 2 March 2027
3. 31 March 2027
4. 30 April 2027

Students can request the new instalment plan from the moment the second instalment is payable and no later than 2 February 2027, by accessing the online service for the payment of tuition and fees.

Once the request for rescheduling has been confirmed, it is no longer possible to pay the second instalment all at once.

Failure to pay the rescheduled instalments by 30 April 2027 will result in the instalment plan being cancelled. In this case, the student will be required to pay the second instalment all at once.

The first instalment of the new plan will be payable as soon as the request for rescheduling is submitted. The second, third and fourth instalments will be payable only after payment of the previous instalment has been received by the University.

Failure to pay any instalment will result in the student's academic career being immediately halted until the debt is settled.

The instalment plan will be cancelled and the student will be required to pay the outstanding amount all at once in the following cases:

- If the student pays any instalment by using a payment method different from the one made available by the University;
- If the student requests an adjustment of the second instalment after 2 February 2027.

Students who pay the fourth instalment after 30 April 2027 will be charged a second instalment late payment fee, and their academic career will be halted.

If a student stops being enrolled at the University of Milan due to withdrawal from studies, transfer or graduation, the instalment plan will be cancelled. Their academic career will be formally closed only once the student pays the full amount of the second instalment, including the late payment fee if applicable.

Students who enrol in the academic year 2026/2027 after 30 November 2026 cannot request that the second instalment be staggered in four monthly payments, but must pay it all at once.

3.5 TUITION FEES FOR ONLINE DEGREE PROGRAMMES

In addition to the all-inclusive fee calculated as per article 3.2, students enrolled in the fully online degree programmes launched by the University in the academic year 2026/2027 — Bachelor's degrees in Management (class L-18 R) and Cybersecurity and Artificial Intelligence (class L-31 R) — must also pay an additional fee in the amount of €500.00 (for students with an ISEE University up to €30,000.00) or €900.00 (for students with an ISEE University above €30,000.00).

Therefore, the **first tuition instalment** for the above-mentioned degree programmes amounts to €646.00 (€130.00 = minimum regional tax + €16.00 = stamp duty + €500.00 = minimum additional fee).

The **amount of the second instalment varies according to each student's ISEE University** and must be paid within 120 days of enrolment.



The maximum payment due as second instalment is €4,561.12. Students who are entitled to a reduction based on their ISEE must request the ISEE University certificate within 60 days of enrolment.

If the amount due as second instalment is at least €700.00, payment of the second instalment can be split into four equal tranches, as follows:

- a) 1st payment: within 120 days of enrolment
- b) 2nd payment: within 150 days of enrolment
- c) 3rd payment: within 180 days of enrolment
- d) 4th payment: within 210 days of enrolment

Failure to comply with these payment deadlines will result in the student's academic career being immediately halted.

With regard to students who enrol in the second or third year of the online Bachelor's degree in Computer Systems and Networks Security (discontinued as of a. y. 2026/2027), the additional fee amounts to €500.00 for on-track students and €200.00 for off-track students. Payment is due by 30 November 2026.

The additional fee is also due by students who suspend their studies.

3.6 TUITION FEES FOR JOINT DEGREES

Students enrolled in joint Bachelor's and Master's degrees that are governed by agreements with foreign universities and are administratively based at the University of Milan must pay the fees set forth in the agreements with which the relevant degrees were instituted. Therefore, the above-mentioned criteria for determining the all-inclusive fee do not apply to these degree programmes.

For the joint Master's degree in Migration Studies and New Societies, which is offered in collaboration with the University of Warsaw and the University of Prague and is administratively based at the University of Milan, the overall tuition fee amounts to €4,500.00 per year.

This amount already includes the regional tax (€130.00) and the stamp duty (€16.00). The overall tuition fee in the amount of €4,500.00 is collected by the University of Milan, which will then transfer funds to the other partner universities as established in the joint degree funding agreement.

The first instalment (€146.00) is due upon enrolment or enrolment renewal. The second instalment (€4,354.00) must be paid by 31 January 2027 and can be split into four equal payments, due at the end of each month from January 2027 to April 2027.

Students enrolled in the above-mentioned joint Master's degree are not entitled to the tuition waivers set forth in Article 15 of these regulations, except for students with a disability at or above 66% and/or a recognised handicap pursuant to art. 3, paragraph 1 of Law no. 104/92, who are granted the full tuition waiver.

Art. 4 – Part-time enrolment

As regards tuition and fees for part-time students, please refer to the University's Student Regulations – Appendix 3. Applications must be submitted between 1 October and 30 October 2026.

Students who want to enrol part-time must pay the first tuition instalment in full.

The second instalment amount will be reduced by 50% or 25% depending on the part-time enrolment option.



Any decision to return to full-time enrolment is retroactive: students who opt out of part-time enrolment will be required to pay the amounts not paid when they were enrolled part-time.

If a student switches from full-time to part-time enrolment, there will be no refund of tuition and fees paid for previous academic years.

If the student graduates earlier, as compared to the duration of their part-time track, the second instalment amounts for part-time years will be adjusted accordingly.

Part-time enrolment is not available for the fully online degree programmes launched in the academic year 2026/2027.

Art. 5 – ISEE certificate for the right to higher education

To obtain a reduction on the second instalment, apply for financial aid and benefits based on economic conditions, or receive the income score for the purposes of 200-hour student collaborations, students must have an ISEE certificate for the right to higher education, hereinafter referred to as ISEE University.

ISEE University certificates are acquired online by the University from the INPS database. The University does not acquire other types of ISEE certificates.

ISEE University certificates are not acquired online if:

- they were requested for other purposes, not linked to the right to higher education
- the student has already requested a rescheduling of the second instalment
- the student has already paid the second instalment.

To obtain a reduction on the second instalment, students must request the ISEE University certificate by 10 October 2026. Students holding an ISEE University certificate valid until 31 December 2026 do not have to request a new certificate.

The University also accepts ISEE University certificates requested between 11 October 2026 and 31 December 2026, but in this case the student will be charged a late declaration fee of €250.00. Only students who have not requested the ISEE University certificate by 10 October 2026 and have not paid the second instalment (either fully or in part) may consider this extended deadline.

Students have no right to a refund if their ISEE University certificate is acquired after payment of the second instalment (either fully or in part), and the amount due is lower than the one that they have already paid.

Students enrolled in the first year of a second-cycle degree programme (Master's degree) who request the ISEE University certificate between 11 October and 31 December 2026 are not charged the late declaration fee.

Those who fail to request the ISEE University certificate by 31 December 2026 will be charged the maximum second instalment amount.

Students who apply to sit the final exam by the third graduation session of the academic year 2025/2026, but then fail to graduate and consequently have to enrol in the academic year 2026/2027, are required to comply with the deadlines regarding the ISEE University certificate and will be charged the late declaration fee.



CURRENT ISEE

For the purposes of obtaining a reduction on the maximum second instalment, students holding an ISEE University certificate may request the current ISEE certificate by the above-mentioned deadlines.

The current ISEE certificate must be requested within the terms set forth by these regulations, and must be valid at the time of acquisition by the University.

For the purposes of compliance with the deadlines and the application of the late declaration fee, the University will take into consideration the date of signature of the Single Substitute Statement (*Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica*, DSU) for the previous ordinary ISEE University certificate, to which the current ISEE refers.

SPECIAL CASES

Students not living with their parents

In application of art. 8 of Prime Minister's Decree (DPCM) no. 159/13, students who do not reside with any of their parents may declare themselves independent from their family of origin and request an ISEE University certificate in which they appear without their parents, if at the date of signature of the Single Substitute Statement both of the following requirements are met:

a) The student's residence, as registered with the city hall, has been outside the housing unit of the family of origin for at least 2 years prior to the date of signature of the Single Substitute Statement, and in a property not owned by a member of the family of origin;

b) The student's working income, as declared in his/her tax returns for the calendar years 2024 and 2025, is no less than €9,000.00 per year. Work within family businesses does not count towards this criterion.

If the student has a spouse or a registered cohabiting partner (article 1, paragraph 36 of Law no. 76/2016), the minimum income requirement is calculated taking into account the income of the spouse or partner. Therefore, provided that the other requirements are met, students can ask for an ISEE University certificate referred to their own household.

Students who fail to meet one or both requirements will be considered part of their parents' household for the purposes of the ISEE University certificate.

Art. 6 – Tuition fees for non-Italian residents with foreign income

Pursuant to art. 8 of DPCM no. 159/13, students who do not reside in Italy and whose household has income and assets outside of Italy cannot request the ISEE University certificate. For these students, the second instalment is a fixed amount based on the student's country of origin and type of enrolment.

For the purpose of establishing the amount of the second instalment due by international students enrolling in the academic year 2026/2027, world countries are divided into three groups, as detailed in Annex 2 (Tables A, B and C), which is an integral part of this document. For new students enrolling in 2026/2027, the amounts of the second instalment per country group are as follows:

For international students already enrolled at the University of Milan who renew enrolment in the a. y. 2026/2027 (including first-year repeaters), the applicable second instalment amounts and country groups are those established by the Regulation on Tuition and Fees, Waivers and Scholarships 2025/2026.

As for the regional tax for the academic year 2026/2027, all international students enrolled in the academic year 2026/2027, regardless of their first year of enrolment, must pay the following amount depending on which group their country of origin falls into, as specified in Annex 2.

For non-Italian residents with Italian citizenship and whose household has income and assets abroad, the amount of the second instalment is fixed and established in reference to their country of residence.

For students enrolled in the Registry of Italians Living Abroad (*Anagrafe Italiani Residenti all'Estero*, AIRE) who qualify as "independent student" or whose household has income and assets abroad, the amount of the second instalment is fixed and established in reference to their country of residence.

Asylum-seekers, refugees and students benefiting from other forms of international protection are not required to pay any tuition.

Non-Italian residents with foreign income who enrol in a fully online degree programme (L-18 R Management or L-31 R Cybersecurity and Artificial Intelligence) must pay the additional fee in the amount specified below, according to their country of origin:

Art. 7 – Application for DSU benefits by non-Italian residents with foreign income and assets

Non-Italian residents whose household has foreign income and assets can apply for student benefits under the right to higher education (formally known as DSU benefits, from the Italian *Diritto allo Studio Universitario*), as long as they meet the merit and financial requirements specified in the respective calls for applications.

When submitting an application for a benefit, the student will be required to upload the documentation for the calculation of the equalised ISEE University value (*ISEE parificato*), for the purpose of determining the economic condition of the household. The list of any documents required and the rule for calculating the equalised ISEE University value are indicated in the specific calls for applications.



List of documents to be produced, if required, for the purposes of receiving DSU benefits:

- Certificate issued by a registry office or other competent public body, according to the law of the country of origin, stating the composition of the household: if there is just one parent, the certificate must specify if the parent is separated, divorced, widowed or non-cohabiting (in this case, details of the other non-cohabiting parent must be provided);
- Documentation issued by the competent offices of the country of origin stating the income earned in calendar year 2025 by all the household members (and specifying whether the income is from employed work, self-employment or pension). If no income has been earned, the documentation must contain a declaration specifying the lack of income for each member of the household;
- Documentation issued by the competent offices of the country of origin attesting to the movable assets owned by all household members as at 31 December 2025: deposits, shares or investment securities, life insurance, the net equity of the corporation or business owned. If no movable property is owned by the family, the documentation must include a declaration attesting to the absence of movable assets for each household member;
- Documentation issued by the competent offices of the country of origin attesting to the immovable assets owned by all household members as at 31 December 2025, with an indication of the square metres of each property. The documentation must specify whether the property is the place of residence or otherwise. Where no property is held, the documentation must include a declaration stating the absence of immovable property for each household member.

The documentation must be issued by the competent authorities of the country where the assets and income were produced, and must be legalised and translated into Italian by an Italian diplomatic or consular representation abroad. For those countries where it is difficult to obtain the documentation from the local Italian Embassy, students can contact the foreign diplomatic or consular representations in Italy: in this case, the certification issued must be legalised by the Prefectures pursuant to art. 33 of Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28 December 2000.

Based on the documentation certifying the income/assets produced abroad, the University calculates the equalised ISEE University value by applying the following rules:

- sum of the income earned by each individual household member in the calendar year 2025;
- 20% of the sum of movable and immovable assets owned by each household member as at 31 December 2025; for the purposes of calculating the value of immovable assets, only buildings will be considered, and valued at €500.00 per square metre;
- the equalised ISEE University is calculated by adding together the above items and by applying the deductibles for income and movable and immovable assets and the equivalence scale set by DPCM no. 159/13.

Art. 8 – Former students whose student status lapsed in the academic year 2025/2026

Former students whose student status lapsed in the academic year 2025/2026 and who renew enrolment for that academic year after the deadline must pay the first and second instalments plus the late enrolment fees.

In order to obtain a reduction on the second instalment, these students may submit the ISEE University certificate after the deadline, and will be charged a late declaration fee.

Art. 9 – Drop-out students

Students enrolled in the academic year 2026/2027 who withdraw from studies after 16 October 2026 and by 2 February 2027 are required to pay either a fixed charge of €400.00 for withdrawal from studies or the second instalment in the amount based on their ISEE University value, whichever is lower.



For those enrolled in the first year of a second-cycle degree programme (Master's degree), the fixed charge of €400.00 is due if withdrawal occurs after 15 January 2027 and no later than 16 February 2027. If the student has already taken exams, this amount will be due even if withdrawal occurs before the dates indicated above. This does not apply to English language and computer skills assessments.

The €400.00 charge must be paid by the deadline specified on the payment notice, and in any case no later than 30 days after submission of the application for withdrawal. Students who fail to pay the fixed charge by this deadline will be required to pay the maximum second instalment.

Students enrolled in the academic year 2026/2027 who withdraw from studies after the above-mentioned dates must pay the maximum second instalment, or the amount due on the basis of the ISEE University certificate.

Students who withdraw from studies after paying the second instalment (either fully or in part) will not be entitled to any refund with respect to the €400 charge or the second instalment amount calculated according to their ISEE University.

Students without an ISEE University certificate may request it beyond the deadlines set out in article 5, with no late declaration fee. No late payment fee will be charged even if the payment is made beyond the deadline.

Drop-out students who fail to submit a formal application for withdrawal are also required to pay the second instalment.

Students who have applied for and obtained DSU benefits may submit a formal application for withdrawal only after settling their debts.

Art. 10 – Provisions for students enrolled in postgraduate programmes

For postgraduate schools of medicine and health, the payment deadlines for the first and second instalments change according to the enrolment cohort.

For other schools, the second instalment is due by 30 April 2027.

Students who suspend their postgraduate studies for maternity or sick leave are required to comply with the deadlines for enrolment and payment of the second instalment as contemplated for their cohort.



For the purposes of enrolment in postgraduate schools, tuition and fees are paid in two instalments but under a single obligation. Therefore, the payment of the first instalment gives rise to the obligation to pay the second instalment as well.

The second instalment is also due by students who drop out or formally withdraw from studies. If the application for withdrawal is submitted before the second instalment payment deadline, a fixed charge of €400.00 will be applied for withdrawal from studies. The €400.00 charge must be paid by the deadline specified on the payment notice. Students who fail to pay the fixed charge by this deadline will be required to pay the second instalment amount.

PhD programmes

PhD students must pay a €15.50 insurance premium, the regional tax for the right to higher education in the amount of €190.00, and a €16.00 stamp duty.

Vocational masters and advanced courses

For vocational masters and advanced courses, enrolment fees and the related payment deadlines are established each year by the academic bodies and specified in the calls for applications.

If withdrawal occurs prior to the actual start of the classes, any fees paid will be reimbursed, minus an amount equal to 10% of the enrolment fee and in any case not lower than €100.00, which will be withheld by the University to cover general and administrative costs.

For the purposes of enrolment in vocational masters, tuition and fees are paid in two instalments but under a single obligation. Therefore, the payment of the first instalment gives rise to the obligation to pay the second instalment as well. The second instalment is also due by students who drop out or formally withdraw from the programme. Rescheduling the second instalment is not permitted.

Postgraduate programmes are subject to the applicable provisions set forth in articles 12, 13, 14 and 15 of these regulations.

Art. 11 – Fees for single courses

To enrol in single courses, students must pay a €180.00 fee for the first single course they enrol in, and a €126.00 fee for each additional single course after the first.

The fees paid for single courses include the student's accident insurance and the stamp duty of €16.00.

Students with a disability equal to or above 66% and/or a recognised handicap pursuant to Law no. 104/92, foreign students enrolled at universities with which specific agreements are in place, foreign students who are participating in inter-university reciprocal programmes, and recipients of scholarships from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs are exempt from course fees, but must pay the €16.00 stamp duty.

Asylum-seekers, refugees and students benefiting from other forms of international protection are exempt from course fees.



Art. 12 – Fees valid for all types of programmes

Art. 13 – Rules for the reimbursement of tuition and fees

The first instalment may be reimbursed only to students who renew their enrolment in the academic year 2026/2027 but graduate within the third session of the previous academic year, provided that they submit an application for reimbursement within 30 days of graduation.

The first instalment is not reimbursed to students who transfer to another university or withdraw to enrol at another university, except where a student withdraws to enrol in a capped programme after moving up in the ranking.

The first instalment is not reimbursed to students who receive DSU benefits for the academic year 2026/2027 but graduate within the academic year 2025/2026.

Students who are awarded a partial regional scholarship are required to pay 50% of the all-inclusive fee. Students who are awarded a partial university scholarship are required to pay the entire all-inclusive fee.

The following are non-refundable:

- tuition and fees related to academic years prior to the year 2026/2027
- application fees for admission to Bachelor's, Master's and postgraduate programmes
- single courses enrolment fees
- fees for transfer from/to another university or programme, credit transfer (recognition of prior learning), enrolment in a second degree programme, simultaneous enrolment in multiple programmes, recognition of a foreign degree
- the second instalment, if the amount already paid is higher than the amount due based on the ISEE University acquired after the payment. This also applies to students who have already submitted an application for withdrawal from studies.

Applications for reimbursement must be submitted to the Student Offices (*Segreterie studenti*), along with a copy of the payment receipts for which reimbursement is requested, and a declaration that the applicant has not received any student benefits. The application for reimbursement must be submitted by the student or a duly authorised person, who will be required to produce an authorisation form signed by the student along with a photocopy of the student's ID.

If the application for reimbursement concerns deceased students, the following documents must be attached to the application:

- affidavit in which the applicant states that there is no will and lists all the legal heirs;
- power of attorney given by the heirs and authorising one of the heirs (or a third party) to submit the application and receive the reimbursement. Please note that the power of attorney must be authenticated at the local town hall.

For all types of reimbursement, the University withholds a €10.00 administrative fee, €2.50 to cover bank fees and €2.00 for the stamp duty (where applicable by law).

Art. 14 – Failure to pay tuition and fees

Students who fail to pay their tuition fees by the applicable deadlines for any year may not continue their academic career: they will not be admitted to exams or the degree examination, and they will not be able to transfer to another university or degree programme. They may not renew enrolment in the academic year 2026/2027, obtain certificates, apply for student vacancies, tuition waivers and scholarships, and in any case submit any application for which student status is required.



If a student passes an exam while being in arrears with payments, the exam result will be cancelled by a Rector's provision.

To withdraw from the University and receive any certificates attesting to their academic history, students must have paid all tuition fees up to the last year of enrolment.

Lapsed students may obtain certificates upon payment of any overdue fees up to the last year of enrolment.

In the case of serious health issues or the birth of a child, students may apply for interruption of studies before the second instalment payment deadline, attaching documents attesting to the grounds for their interruption. The first instalment already paid may be settled with the amount to be paid on resumption of studies. In any event, no refund may be granted.

The University of Milan will halt the academic career and start debt collection procedures against students who have failed to pay tuition fees or to repay any benefits that were subsequently cancelled. To this end, the University will send a written payment reminder to the residence address provided by the student at the time of enrolment. It is the student's responsibility to promptly communicate any changes in their residence address.

Art. 15 – Tuition waiver

Tuition waivers may be granted automatically or upon request by eligible students, as described here below.

15.1 Automatic waiver

Full waiver from university tuition

- Students with a disability equal to or higher than 66% and/or a recognised handicap pursuant to art. 3, paragraph 1 of Law no. 104/92 who benefited from the same type of waiver in the academic year 2025/2026: these students will also have a waiver on the regional tax for the right to higher education; students enrolled in the online degree programmes will also have a waiver on the additional fee.
- Students receiving total DSU scholarships
- Students receiving total university scholarships
- Ukrainian citizens
- Students of Bachelor's, Master's and single-cycle Master's degree programmes enrolled in the ordinary courses of the University School for Advanced Studies IUSS Pavia.
- Students enrolled on-track or off-track for one year falling into the categories set forth in art. 30 of Law no. 118 of 30 March 1971: mutilated and legally disabled persons who suffered a decrease of more than two-thirds in their work ability, children of people who receive a disability pension, war orphans, blind people, as well as mutilated and disabled war veterans, workers and civil servants and their children, provided that they belong to economically disadvantaged households (to be considered as part of an economically disadvantaged household, students must have an ISEE University value not higher than €30,000.00).

Partial waiver from university tuition (50%)

- Students receiving partial DSU scholarships



Partial waiver of €500.00 (to be deducted from the second instalment, if higher)

This waiver is granted to students who, in the academic year 2026/2027, are enrolled on track in the second or third year of a degree programme, with a regular academic record, and, by 30 September 2026, have earned 90% of their academic credits, as required by the Programme Description of their degree programme for the preceding academic year.

For students enrolled in the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes in healthcare professions, or the single-cycle degree programmes in Medicine and Surgery, internship credits are assessed on 30 November 2026.

For activities spread over several years or semesters with a single exam, all credits are understood as referring to the year in which the exam should be taken, as specified in the Programme Description.

The regularity of the academic record is assessed with reference to the standard duration of the degree programme in which the student is enrolled in the academic year 2026/2027, considering the date of first enrolment. Students who have interrupted their studies, have repeated or are repeating a year or already hold another degree of the same level are excluded from the scope of this waiver.

Transfer students who have repeated a year are entitled to this waiver. For students transferring from another degree programme of the University of Milan in the academic year 2026/2027, the 90% merit requirement refers to the number of credits required by their original programme. For students transferring from another university in the academic year 2026/2027, or from another programme or university during an academic year prior to 2026/2027, the merit requirement refers to the number of credits required by the last programme in which the student was enrolled. For all transfer students, the waiver may be granted only if the student has repeated a year no more than once throughout their career.

Part-time students are not entitled to the merit-based waiver requiring 90% of the credits.

15.2 Waiver upon request

Without prejudice to the provisions of article 15.3, applications for a waiver must be submitted online from 1 October to 30 October 2026, after renewing enrolment in the academic year 2026/2027, and after applying for the ISEE University certificate (if specifically required for the type of waiver).

Full tuition waiver for students receiving scholarships from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs

Full tuition waiver for students graduating within the standard duration

Students who complete their studies within the statutory number of years as of the date of first enrolment, without enrolling as off-track or repeating students, and graduate with a final mark of 110/110, will be entitled to a full waiver on the all-inclusive fee for the last year of enrolment, provided that their ISEE University value does not exceed €40,000.00.

This type of waiver is not available for graduates who have obtained transfer credits from a previous career, except in the case of a change of programme.

The application for this waiver must be submitted within 30 days from the graduation date. Part-time students are excluded from this kind of waiver.

Waiver for disabled students with a disability equal to or greater than 66%

Students with a disability equal to or above 66% or a recognised handicap pursuant to article 3, paragraph 1, of Law no. 104 of 5 February 1992 are entitled to a waiver on the all-inclusive fee and the regional tax. If they are enrolled in an online degree programme, they also have a waiver on the additional fee.

The application must be submitted exclusively by students who did not receive the same benefit in the academic year 2025/2026.



Waiver for disabled students with a disability lower than 66%

Applications are assessed by a special board, which will lay out the criteria for granting the waiver and the amount of the waiver, where applicable.

€100.00 reduction on the all-inclusive fee

This reduction applies to students whose household has more than one member enrolled at this University for the academic year 2026/2027, and an ISEE University value not exceeding €40,000.00.

The application must be submitted by each household member who is entitled to the reduction. This type of reduction can be combined with other waivers.

15.3 General rules regarding tuition and fee waivers

The following general rules apply to the different types of waivers:

Students enrolled in postgraduate schools, PhD programmes, vocational masters and advanced courses may be granted only waivers governed by national regulations, namely the waivers for recipients of scholarships from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the waivers for students with a disability equal to or above 66% and/or a recognised handicap pursuant to Law no. 104/92.

The regional tax for the right to higher education and the stamp duty (€16.00) are excluded from the scope of the waiver.

A waiver on the regional tax is granted to disabled persons with a disability equal to or greater than 66% and/or with a recognised handicap pursuant to Law no. 104/92.

Students benefiting from a waiver are required to pay any fees for late re-enrolment or late submission of the ISEE University certificate, and the second instalment balance, if due, by the respective deadlines, by accessing their UNIMIA personal account (section Payment Services).

Art. 16 – Income scores for the purposes of student collaborations

The income scores provided for in the regulations governing student collaborations are awarded according to the following criteria:

Non-Italian residents whose household has foreign income and assets can apply for student collaborations, but will be assigned a standard income score based on their country of origin, as listed in Annex 2 of this document.

Students from countries listed in table A = 48 points

Students from countries listed in table B = 36 points

Students from countries listed in table C = 24 points



Art. 17 – Scholarships

The University provides the following types of scholarships:

1. regional scholarships for the right to higher education (DSU scholarships)
2. 1,055 university scholarships of €1,800.00
3. 30 European Futures Scholarships (*Supporting excellence in the European Education Area*) of €10,000.00, reserved for Master's degree students residing in an EU country, provided that they have earned a Bachelor's degree from a university established in the European Union.
4. 31 scholarships awarded in the framework of the IUPALS project, reserved for Palestinian students residing in the Palestinian territories;
5. 36 scholarships of €1,500.00, reserved for students enrolled in the first year of a Bachelor's, Master's, or single-cycle Master's degree programme who, after passing the relevant selection process, have enrolled in the ordinary courses of the University School for Advanced Studies IUSS Pavia, in accordance with the agreement signed by the University of Milan, IUSS and the Collegio di Milano.

For the rules governing each type of scholarship, please refer to the respective calls for applications as well as to the internal regulations of the University.

Students enrolled in joint degrees that are governed by specific agreements with foreign universities and are administratively based at the University of Milan are not entitled to the scholarships mentioned in these Regulations, as financial aid and benefits are governed solely by the respective agreements with which the degree programmes were instituted.

Art. 18 – Tax inspections and penalties

The University of Milan will check the accuracy of the Single Substitute Statement (*Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica*) filed by students to request the ISEE University certificate for the purposes of obtaining DSU benefits, university scholarships and tuition waivers (both automatic waivers and waivers upon request). The University will use any means at its disposal, including the tax register, to undertake any investigation it deems appropriate, by requesting information from the State Financial Administration, the Cadastral Offices, and the Tax Police. Please refer to the regulations concerning the criteria for accuracy checks on Single Substitute Statements submitted by students for the purposes of applying for benefits granted by the University of Milan.

If data provided by the student does not match tax evidence or the findings of any checks carried out through Financial Offices and the *Guardia di Finanza* (Italian police force with economic and financial crime-fighting competences), the student will be required to pay the amount due based on his/her ISEE University value, and a penalty as provided for in the regulations concerning the criteria for accuracy checks on Single Substitute Statements.

Any false statements will be reported to the competent judicial authority.
