## TRANSFERS OF STUDENTS FROM OTHER ITALIAN UNIVERSITIES TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MILAN

- Transfer applications from eligible students shall be granted <u>subject to</u> the availability of spaces on the chosen campus. Applicants must produce all the documents required by the degree programme regulations.
- Transfer applications for admission into <u>the first programme year</u> as <u>repeating student</u> shall not be accepted as available spaces are filled by newly enrolled students.
  - For the purposes of admission into the second year, the student must have passed, in addition to the internship exam, at least 4 exams including Anatomy and Physiology - Clinical Nursing Sciences 1 - General Nursing Sciences (art. 20 of Academic Regulations).
  - For the purposes of admission into the third year, the student must have passed, in addition to the internship exam, at least nine exams, of which, in addition to the exams required to enrol in the second year: Basic Sciences - Clinical Nursing Sciences 2 - Medicine and Pharmacology (art. 20 of Academic Regulations).
- Transfer applications that would result in a student demotion, based on their transcript of records, may not be accepted.
- For the purposes of transfer credits, course syllabi must be submitted. Moreover, subject areas (SSD) and credits (CFU) must be specified for each discipline covered by the course in question.
- The board shall transfer eligible students to the chosen campus, until all available spaces are filled, and subsequently to other campuses with additional vacancies.
- Regardless of the possibility of granting the application, all transfer and transfer-credit applications shall be assessed. The board shall specify into which programme year the applicant may be admitted and, where possible, to which campus they shall transfer.
- Transfer shall take place at the beginning of the following academic year.
